

DRUGS IN SCHOOL – SUPERINTENDENT’S OR SUPERINTENDENT’S DESIGNEE’S  
REVIEW

The Superintendent or the Superintendent’s Designee is authorized to conduct a preliminary review of a case in which a student brings alcohol, a controlled substance, imitation controlled substance, or marijuana or drug paraphernalia onto school property or to a school-sponsored activity. Based on the facts of the case, the Superintendent or the Superintendent’s Designee may determine whether disciplinary action other than expulsion is appropriate.
